You may hang your work as early as Feb. 12th by appointment.

Please, include "Festival" in the subject and limit the file size to 350 KB.
Include dimensions HxWxD. If it is over 35 lbs., include the weight.

installation and removal times 2 - 6:00 PM

Gallery installations: February 15th & 16th.
Lobby Area installations: February 16th & 17th
Deadline for removal is 6:00 PM, Feb. 24th, 2006.

Works should be brought to the **Salon & Gallery** entrance at the rear of the Millennium Center. All participants will be responsible for the delivery, display, and removal of works.
Loading dock doors are clear and average 8'-0" on the diagonal. **Plan accordingly.**

works which hang on a wall

Works should be prepared for suspension from picture rail. The Millennium Center staff reserves the option to disallow any work not prepared for easy, safe display.
Maximum: 3 pieces or 25 square feet of wall space per individual membership.
Early entrants will receive the benefit of best placement in formal galleries.

freestanding works

Maximum: 9 square feet of floor space. Ceiling height varies from 10' - 17'.
Each artist will need to supply their own pedestal and/or case if desired.

suspended, projected, or live works

A screening schedule may be generated. Please list the duration of entry.
